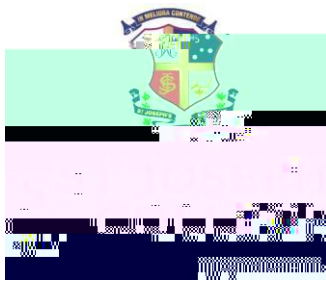

## 1. PREAMBLE

St Joseph's College ('the College') is a Catholic school that draws its primary purpose and identity, and shapes its values and priorities, from the gospel of Jesus Christ. The College seeks to be a safe, just, compassionate, responsive and inclusive place for all its students, employees, contractors and volunteers. The College policies are pursuant to Section 47 of the Education Act 1900. Under the Act, the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) is responsible for monitoring the compliance of non-government schools with the registration and accreditation requirements of the Act. All College Staff and Personnel must comply with this Policy. The College may take disciplinary action in the event of non-compliance. It is a mandatory requirement for all persons to follow this policy.
